

March Charity of the Month: The Muscular Dystrophy Association (MDA) "Seek a Miracle"



Many of you have heard of MDA or even Jerry's Kids but most of you don't know that there are 43 forms of Muscular Dystrophy. Our Aerie Brother, Mike Austin is afflicted with one called Friedrich's Ataxia.

Friedrich's Ataxia is a childhood disease caused by a recessive gene. As such, it can in part be passed from generation to generation without a known history until two carries get together as parents. When this happens, <u>each</u> pregnancy has a 1 in 4 chance of developing this disease - they will be carriers.

Symptoms vary in time of onset, but the first noticeable symptoms usually start in the extremities, then it works inward to the core of the body and affect swallowing, speech, and breathing, often diabetes is developed. Until recently, life expectancy for these children was early to mid-20s and usually they died from choking or complications of pneumonia.

We are proud to say Mike celebrated his 48th birthday in February and he feels that it is his mission to do what he can to keep other children from suffering as he has. So, for our charity, we are working on a fund called "Seek a Miracle" which goes strictly to research efforts for a Friedrich's Ataxia cure. The underlying thought is if they can find a cure for one type of MD then it maybe a stepping-stone for the other forms as well.






