Thank you Cissy for all you have done and are doing.






us are going. We will also be helping Dave and Kari celebrate their honeymoon while we are there.

Guardians of the West is a nonprofit corporation that serves as legal guardian, advocate, and care manager for incapacitated and isolated adults in Western Colorado. This nonprofit was just started. We already have 1 ward. We need funding to make this a reality!

"By 2030, more than 2 million adults over the age of 70 will have outlived all of their friends and family members," leaving them without anyone to advocate for their needs if incapacitated. The issue is so large that Colorado is addressing guardianship as a statewide problem. Unfortunately, estates cannot often afford forprofit agencies that serve as guardian. GUARDIANS OF THE WEST will fill that role for at least 8 qualifying people per year. "Each ward could cost between \$3,000 and \$7,800 per year." If an adult in the community appears to exhibit incapacity issues, a person interested in the individual's welfare may initiate a petition for a guardianship proceeding to determine if the person satisfies the legal standard of incapacity. 


