Make sure you see our schedule of events and menu in this newsletter.

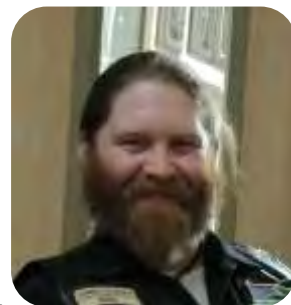

Hi Sisters and Brothers,

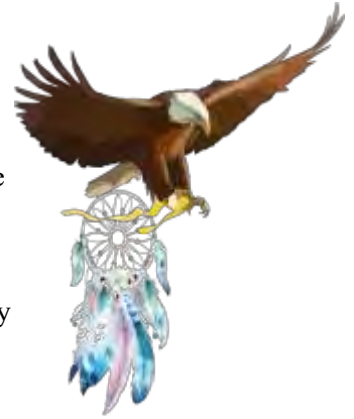

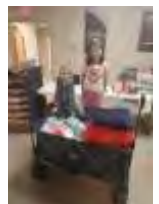
