


Charity Of The Month Christmas in July!

We wish everyone a safe and happy 4th of July!






With all your help, we got the trees trimmed, the weeds cleared and the parking lot paved. It looks awesome!!


Auxiliary Volunteer of the Month: Debi Drake

Greetings everyone,

Our annual B.A.D. Ride Poker Run is in the books. To say it was a huge success would be an understatement.

We had 138 participants and raised over \$8500 for Diabetes Education at Community Hospital. Our previous best turnout was last year at 94 people. It continues to grow every year. All the money raised during the month of June will be added to this total



and the funds get used to send 50-60 kids with Type 1 Diabetes and their families to summer camp next year.

We also did a special giveaway in June where we sold squares for a Pit Boss Pellet Smoker. The \$500 we raised from that giveaway is being sent to Aerie #3948 in Aurora, Missouri to benefit the victims' families that were involved in a tragedy on June 3, 2023. While their Eagle Riders were on their annual Toy Drive, an impaired driver in a car, crossed the centerline and hit 5 motorcycles, head on, killing 4 and seriously injuring 6. We are joining efforts with other Eagle Rider Chapters in Colorado and sending in money they raised and ours together.

Please remember to look twice and save a life, motorcycles are everywhere. And for all our fellow riders, keep the shiny side up and the rubber side down!


